## Ca' la Bionda, Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2018

The Classico Amarone from Ca' La Bionda is very expressive of Marano and its limestone-based soils, with east and southeast exposures. Opening with a raspberry-coulis sweetness, baking spice and cinnamon buns, it is warming and rounded, with generous, fruit-driven appeal that stops short of cloying, anchored with polished wood and maduro tobacco

basenotes. This same warm sensation of fruit coulis dominates the front but is quickly offset by a cedarwood and tobacco-leaf freshness and very bright, beautiful acidity. This is obviously a wine of tension, its dense, fruit-infused frame offset by piercing acidity and hemmed in by firm but supple gabardine tannins on the back.
