The 2019 vintage of Ravazzól, not yet released, is in an interesting phase of development. Much less dark and brooding than in previous vintages, its nose is open and lively, with generously ripe strawberry fruit, a powerful hit of coffee bean and an edifying matcha-powder greenness. Loose-textured and open on the entry, if not particularly acidic, it is marked by that same blond-coffee note, with hints of bay leaf and fennel frond. Tannins are penetrating and angular, compensating for the mild acidity, while the finish has a tonic bitterness. It needs more time to integrate its structure, but the underlying quality is impressive.
